Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

It's been a few months since you welcomed me in person, and so much has happened at Galileo Church since then. Our worship attendance has grown by another 20% to 60 or more people on Sunday evenings. We have added another weekly Bible & Beer gathering for conversation, Bible study, and making Christian friends. We have ordained our first ministry candidate. We have hired a babysitter to help with all our babies and toddlers, with more on the way in months to come! We're hosting the TBA Assembly on May 15, and we are getting ready to welcome at least one, and maybe two, ministry interns from Brite Divinity School in the fall.

Most of all, though, we continue to welcome people who thought God didn't want them — or that the people of God would not be a good fit for them. Just this morning, our weekly G-Study group sat in a coffee shop discussing how we read the Bible in a post-modern age. A young woman interrupted our gathering to say, "I have been looking for a church just like this. I haven't been in church in so long, but from listening to your conversation, I feel like I could bring my daughter and we could finally feel at home." She has her reasons — and I don't know what they are yet — but she has been seeking, waiting, and wishing for a church family to call her own. Now, thanks in part to your support and encouragement, she has a chance to have what we have all enjoyed for so long.

Galileo Church is a missionary outpost to a generation that is hungry for God, and hoping for the people of God to welcome them home. Thank you for going with us on this journey. Please keep us in your prayers, as we pray for you.
