Dear Beloved Church Family,

It has been a sacred honor to serve as your Senior Minister for the last 16 years and (nearly) nine months. This is a congregation of extraordinary grace and love. As nominally competent as I am with words, my gratitude for your generosity is beyond expression.

Even though I have anticipated my promotion from the pulpit to the pew, pastoral ethics require that I be somewhat scarce for the balance of 2017. While I will always love and cherish you as my friends—and that friendship, by God's grace, will endure to the end of my earthly life—please remember that I am no longer Senior Minister of First Christian Church. The tasks

of parish ministry will be assumed by Rev. Renee Hoke as Acting Senior Minister.

As most of you know, Renee is endowed with many gifts and graces, not least of which is her love for our church family. She will not only fill the pulpit, she will also be the pastor for hospital visits and hospice vigils. She will conduct Pastor's Class and officiate at weddings. Even though we have agreed that, for the balance of her tenure as Acting Senior Minister, I would be available to offer eulogies for members with whom I had a long-standing pastoral relationship, funerals will be officiated by Renee, and I may assist only by her invitation at the request of the family. She will also be the one who provides pastoral counseling and any necessary referrals. In pastoral matters, your first call should always be to her.

Please extend to Renee all of the love, prayers and consideration you have so generously extended to me. Please pray, too, for her new colleagues in ministry, Josh deSteiguer and Claire Baer. Please support and pray for our elders, deacons and other church leaders. Please pray for and support our wonderful church staff, who have carried me these many years. Pray, too, for the Search Committee as it begins its quest to discern the next Senior Minister for this beautiful and blessed church.

Thank you again for the sacred honor you have granted me. After my hiatus away, I look forward to claiming my promotion from the pulpit to the pew. God bless and keep you all, beloved brothers and sisters in Christ.

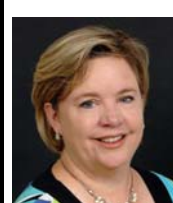
Sunday Morning: Sunday school at 9:45 in room 213 (additional Sunday school classes coming soon)

New on the Library Shelves. . .

Sources of Strength, Meditations on Scripture for a Living Faith, by Jimmy Carter

President Jimmy Carter has taught the adult Sunday school class at his hometown Baptist Church for years. In this book he has selected fifty-two of his favorite Bible meditations from these Sunday gatherings to share with you. Based on passages from both the Old and New Testaments, these lessons reflect themes that touch every life. Sources of Strength is an invitation to share in the spiritual bounty of scripture and the joyous, more fulfilling life that a living faith makes possible.

We Give to Love, Notes and Quotes on the Joys of Heartfelt Service, by John Roger

If you are a natural giver you will find this book an enjoyable affirmation of what you already know; it is more blessed to give than receive and more enjoyable too. The author makes the point that being of service to others is a selfish act. We give because it feels good to give. That others may be helped by our giving is merely a pleasant secondary benefit.

Building a Biblical Faith by Charles H. Bayer

As the pastor of a Disciples church in St. Joseph, Missouri, Rev. Bayer felt that there was a problem in finding texts suitable for teaching courses about Christian theology to his congregation. So he wrote this book to assist layfolk and ministers bridge the gulf between what ministers learn in seminary and the theological viewpoints held by many churchgoers.

He hoped that it could be used in organized courses of study or read by laypeople independently. It deals with the Bible honestly and opens up theology in a way that should help in articulating what we believe and why.

## MEET ME AT THE NEIGHBORHOOD ON WEDNESDAYS THIS FALL

We're one year into our experience of building a midweek community at FCC. (Watch for a birthday party next month!) The rhythm of gathering every Wednesday in Fellowship Hall has become an important part of the faith journey for those who attend.

### MEAL at 5:30 pm

First, there's time to eat and catch up with each other. Parents, grandparents, kids—one big family enjoying time around the table together.

### WORSHIP

We move from the midweek meal to a very relaxed style of worship—songs we love, simple prayers, then a lively, interactive children's message offered by our new Children's Minister Claire Baer. Now it is time for the children depart for their own special activities.

Next comes the message, which looks a lot like small group Bible study. Renee presents the theme, often with a short video to get us thinking, and then we divide into groups of 8-10 around the tables for discussion questions that help us explore scripture and faith issues as we get to know each other.

After a simple service of communion, a beautiful musical offering by our gifted musicians, and a prayer circle so that we can pray for each other in the days ahead.

Meals available in the church kitchen on the first and third Wednesdays.





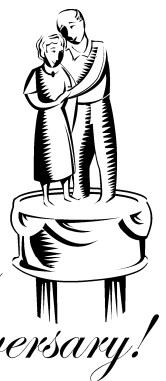

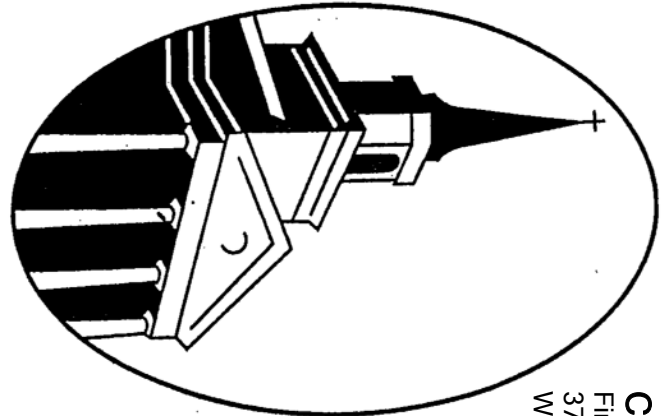
