# Make Your Mark

## Spiritual Profiling (Part 2)

In the last *Make Your Mark* column, I noted that Lent is a season for personal reflection and for growing through repentance, fellowship, prayer, fasting, and focused concentration on who it is that we profess as our Lord and Savior. It also is a time to consider the way(s) that we approach our spiritual growth and enhance our relationship with Jesus Christ. To help us think about this, I described Corinne Ware's four spiritual types - **head, heart, mystic, and kingdom**.

Another way of thinking about our approach to God is to consider the nine distinct spiritual temperaments described by Gary Thomas. In his book, *Sacred Pathways*, Thomas suggests that each person, designed uniquely by our Creator, walks a particular route with God. This route or "sacred pathway" describes the way that we relate to God, how we draw near to God. Thomas proposes that we don't necessarily have just one pathway (or temperament) for approaching God. But whatever temperament (pathway) or blend of temperaments (pathways) best describes our walk helps us identify the way we most naturally express our relationship with Jesus Christ.

Consider which one(s) of these nine pathways "free you to be you" in your worship of God:

### Activists - Loving God Through Confrontation

Activists describe worship as standing against evil and calling sinners to repentance. They often view the church as a place to recharge their batteries so that they can go back into the world to wage war against injustice. They are energized by interaction with others, even in conflict.

### Ascetics - Loving God in Solitude and Simplicity

Ascetics are introspective Christians who want nothing more than to be left alone in prayer. They would be happy with the removal of liturgy, the trappings of religion, the noise of the outside world, or anything else that would distract them from silence and simplicity.

### Caregivers - Loving God by Loving Others

Caregivers often claim to see Christ in the poor and needy, and their faith is enhanced by interacting with and serving others. They might view the devotional lives of the contemplatives or enthusiasts as selfish, as they are rejuvenated by caring for others.

### Contemplatives - Loving God Through Adoration

Images of a loving Father and Bridegroom dominate the

view of a Contemplative. They focus, not necessarily on serving God, doing God's will, accomplishing great things in God's name, or obeying God, but in loving God with the purest, deepest, and brightest love imaginable.

### Enthusiasts - Loving God with Mystery and Celebration

The spiritual lifeblood of Enthusiasts is excitement and mystery in worship. They want to be inspired by joyful celebration. If their hearts aren't moved or they don't experience God's power, something is missing. Enthusiasts are cheerleaders for God and the Christian life.

### Intellectuals - Loving God with the Mind

Intellectuals might be skeptics or committed believers, but in either case are likely to be studying and living in a world of concepts. They are fed by intellectual activity and believe faith is something to be understood as much as experienced. They may feel closest to God when they learn something new about God.

### Naturalists - Loving God Out of Doors -

These Christians believe that nature clearly proclaims "God is!" Naturalists would prefer to leave any building, however beautiful or austere, to pray to God beside a river or on a walk through the woods, mountains, or open meadows. Naturalists may learn more from watching an ant colony or looking at a peaceful lake than from reading a book or listening to a sermon.

### Sensates - Loving God with the Senses

Sensates want to be lost in the awe, beauty, and splendor of God. They are drawn particularly to the liturgical, the majestic, and the grand. In worship, they want to be filled with sights, sounds, and smells that overwhelm them, and their hearts soar because of things like incense, intricate architecture, classical music, and formal language.

### Traditionalists - Loving God Through Ritual and Symbol

Traditionalists tend to have a disciplined life of faith and have a need for ritual and structure. They are fed by historic dimensions of faith such as rituals, symbols, sacraments, and sacrifice. They define their faith largely by matters of conduct (regular attendance at church, tithing, etc.).

As I wrote last time (and it bears repeating), spiritual type and temperaments *indicate the reasons some people worship God one particular way while others choose a very different way of expressing religious devotion. However, one type is not better or preferable to another. They are simply ways of thinking about and describing the way we choose to connect with God.* This Lenten season, I hope that you are intentionally finding ways to draw closer to God...and perhaps by seeking to do so through your primary spiritual type or temperament, you are finding a rich and rewarding experience with Jesus Christ.

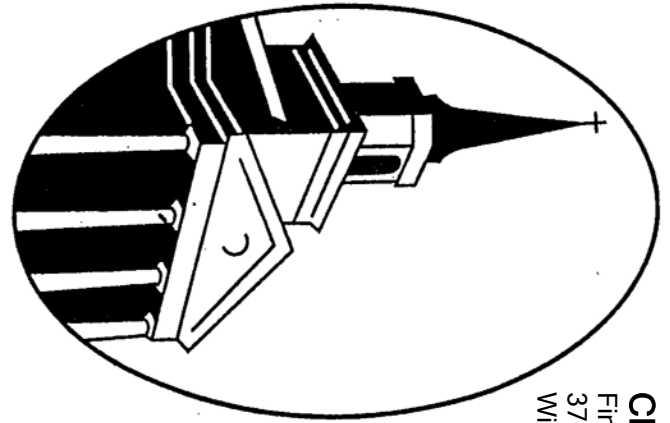
