Pantry Sunday — October 25th

For families who struggle financially, providing diapers for their young children is a huge challenge leading to a cycle of difficulty.

* Diapers cost up to \$100-150 per month, per baby.

* Many parents have to choose between buying food or diapers.

* Food Stamps cannot be used for diapers.

* Babies without disposable diapers are turned away from childcare.

* Parents without access to childcare can't go to work.

FCC's Outreach Partner, Interfaith Outreach, supplies each child with a large supply (80-100 depending on size) every 30 days through our Diaper Chest. Sizes 3 - 6 are preferred.

Help fill the shelves at Interfaith Outreach this **Sunday, October 25th**.

Bring packages of diapers, or monetary donations to serve these babies in need!

A Bucket List

If we did the things we were capable of, we would astound ourselves.

-Thomas Edison

One of the values we've named as a church is being *Intentional in our Growth*. This is the idea that, both individually and collectively, we should be attending to our spiritual growth and personal growth. And one of the ways the church supports this value is through the continuing education opportunities afforded to its staff.

Since many of the traditional continuing education opportunities for 2020 were cancelled or modified as a result of the global pandemic (including the Disciples Clergy Conference I was scheduled to attend in September), I began looking at other things that would enable me to be intentional in my growth as your pastor. This led me to select a 30-day experience during the month of October known as *Younique* (www.lifeyouunique.com).

Younique is a gospel-centered, life planning process created by Will Mancini, the author of *Church Unique* and founder of Auxano, the firm we have used here at the church to help us clarify our identity and vision. While there will be more to say about this process after I finish it later this month, one of the exercises we were asked to complete got me thinking. It was an exercise known as the Bucket List.

Some of you are familiar with the idea of a bucket list. The 2007 movie entitled "The Bucket List," which featured Morgan Freeman and Jack Nicholson, embedded this term in our social vocabulary. The movie plot revolved around two terminally ill men who escape the cancer ward with a to-do list to accomplish before they "kick the bucket."

The first step in the bucket list exercise is to create a set of goals to accomplish and/or things to do before we die. The purpose behind this is not to create a long list of narcissistic, selfish tasks. The purpose, first and foremost, is to see in this list what is really required to propel us toward our dreams. The likelihood that we cross everything off this list may be small, but having something to drive towards is large. It allows us to dream big God-inspired dreams.

The bucket list exercise asked us to begin listing our aspirations in five categories:

- Things to do (e.g. go skydiving, attend the World Series)
- Places to go (e.g. hike the Grand Canyon, Visit 10 European cathedrals)
- Skills to learn (e.g. take a photography class, learn to play chess proficiently)

- Objectives to Achieve (e.g. save \$100,000, run a marathon)
- Possessions to Obtain (e.g. collect one of every Lincoln penny, own an airplane)

Once we had taken time to brainstorm and create a list, we were asked to run our list through four filters:

1. How is this goal facilitating deeper intimacy or special bonding with people?
2. How is this goal enabling personal re-creation or particular inspiration?
3. How is this goal providing a general blessing or unique investment?
4. How is this goal promoting increased faith or gospel advancement?

These filters are designed to prevent us from setting goals that are simply self-driven rather than God-inspired. They "filter out" selfishness and help redefine or redirect our aspirations.

I'm not done with my bucket list yet, but it's been a fun and challenging process - one that has caused me to further examine where I can be better in terms of health (both physical and spiritual), love, work, and play.

As I have reflected upon this process, I wondered about whether we have a bucket list as a church. Now, I'm not suggesting that the church will one day "kick the bucket." My prayer is that we will continue to be a witness for Jesus Christ and the good news he provides for many years to come. But it is healthy for a church to have dreams. And as I mentioned last month, one of those bucket list dreams for us as a church is to *go from One Table to 5,000 by 2025*, filling 3,500 empty tables, 1,000 neighborhood tables, 300 family tables, and 200 leadership tables. This is a big vision - one that will take a lot of work and a substantial blessing from God. But as I looked at this vision, I realized that it had been through the four filters above. It facilitates special bonds. It enables particular inspiration. It promotes a unique investment in our community.

And, if we can get it right, it advances the gospel.

I would encourage you to capture the four filters listed above and to put them in strategic places - attach it to your monthly budget worksheets; put them in your travel-planning file; affix it to your calendar and to-do list; maybe even place it in your Bible. Put them in places where you are thinking about goals. And, when inspiration strikes you about something you or the church could do, run that idea through these filters as well. They are a tool for helping us see if our inspiration is God-inspired or self-driven.

Paul wrote in 2 Corinthians:

...and he died for all, that those who live might no longer live for themselves, but for him who for their sake died and was raised. (5:15)

Is that how you are living your life? Is this an area you need to intentionally grow?

ONLINE GIVING—A SIMPLE SOLUTION

A quick trip to the church website reveals an “online giving” button at the top of the home page. This convenient form of stewardship allows our members to give automatically (you choose the interval) using a credit card or a bank draft. Some of our members like using credit cards because they are earning points toward travel. If you prefer to avoid credit cards, the bank draft option ensures that your gift arrives regularly to support ministry at FCC. The benefit for our members in online giving is avoiding the stress of “catching up” each fall when there are other demands on the family budget. Please visit the church website at www.firstchristianwf.com and see for yourself how simple online giving can be.

“UNITE” App

The “Unite” App is your church directory that is accessible through your smart phone, easily updated, and allows you to manage your photo with an easy upload process. For our members who prefer a paper copy of the directory, they will be available soon.

Here are the simple steps to follow using your smart phone:

- Visit the Google Play or Apple App store to download the “RDS Unite” app onto your phone.
- Once the download is complete, open the app and add the First Christian Church code **14351** in the space provided for the organizational church code.
- Now tap “register here” and enter your email address. It is important that you use the email address on file in the church office. If you encounter problems on this step, call the church office so we can confirm the email address we have on file.
- Now set your password. Then tap register. A confirmation email will be sent to you immediately. Follow the instructions in the email and you’re all set.
- When you open the directory next, tap on the square menu icon found middle right just under the church name. Next tap “My Family” and then tap “Family Photo.” There are several ways to select photos depending on the device you use.

Problems? Just call the church office and Cheryl Appling will walk you through.

If you select this option, you will receive a phone call connecting you to the worship service audio stream every Sunday. You don't have to remember to call us...we'll call you!


