## What Did You Learn?

*We've all heard, "Experience is the best teacher." But, John Maxwell states, "Experience is not the best teacher; evaluated experience is the best teacher. Reflective thinking is needed to turn an experience into insight. We draw lessons from the past only when we study it."*

At a Staff Meeting in mid-December, I gave our wonderful church staff a homework assignment. It wasn't something for them to do before Christmas...after all, they are a little busy then. Instead, it was something to think about as the year drew to a close. This assignment consisted of four questions:

1. What did you learn about yourself in 2020?
2. What did you learn about others on staff in 2020? (I asked them to name something specific about three teammates.)
3. What did you/we accomplish in 2020 that you are most proud of?
4. What did you do/learn in 2020 that won't stop going forward?

This is a good exercise for any year, but it felt especially important for this past year - a year that saw so much disruption in the way we did ministry. It was helpful to see what sort of learning we did personally and collectively.

I am so proud of the team we have assembled here at First Christian Church! As we shared our answers to these questions in Staff Meeting this week, it was obvious that each had given careful thought to how they had grown and what they had learned about themselves. It was also fun to see what they had learned about other

members of our team. Things like: *Susan is unflappable, even when nearly every system she knew had to be reconfigured; Karen brings such a pastoral heart to the work she does in the office; Claire's theater training gave her a leg up on all the rest of us when it came to doing online worship; and Shaun and Preston do so many tasks with a heart for FCC's ministry.*

We also developed an amazing list of accomplishments that we could celebrate about 2020. I'll talk more about that in future publications, but the creativity, resiliency, and resourcefulness of our staff contributed mightily to what our church was able to do in the midst of a pandemic.

Most years, the transition between December and January is marked by a time of reflection (remembering all of the key events of the previous year) and a time of

goal setting (New Year's resolutions). However, this year, it seemed like very few people wanted to look back at 2020. Nearly all of us were ready for the fresh start we hoped 2021 would bring. But, let me encourage you to answer those four questions above (tweaking them for your own settings). What did you learn about yourself? What did you start doing in 2020 that you will keep doing going forward?

In addition to thinking about these questions, let me also challenge you to be spiritually reflective about 2020. Where did you see God moving in 2020? Where did you grow in your walk with Christ? What challenges of faith did you encounter?

I've written about it before, but let me recommend to you the *Prayer of Examen* as a tool for this spiritual reflection. After an unfortunate wartime injury, Ignatius of Loyola (1491-1556) devoted his life to becoming an expert in spiritual direction. The *Prayer of Examen* became one of the tools St. Ignatius of Loyola found helpful for reviewing one's spiritual health. By regularly and prayerfully reflecting on the events of the day, Ignatius felt that one could better detect God's presence and discern God direction for them.

The steps of the daily *Prayer of Examen* are:

1. **Become aware of God's presence.** Look back on the events of the day in the company of the Holy Spirit.
2. **Review the day with gratitude.** Walk through your day in the presence of God and note its joys and delights. Focus on the day's gifts. Look at the work you did, the people you interacted with. What did you receive from these people? What did you give them? Pay attention to small things—God is in the details.
3. **Pay attention to your emotions.** Reflect on the feelings you experienced during the day. Boredom? Elation? Resentment? Compassion? Anger? Confidence? What is God saying through these feelings? Do these emotions indicate a way you fell short? Does a feeling of frustration mean that God wants you consider a new direction in some area?
4. **Choose one feature of the day and pray from it.** Ask the Holy Spirit to direct you to something during the day that God thinks is particularly important. It may involve a feeling—positive or negative. It may be a significant encounter with another person or a vivid moment of pleasure or peace. Or it may be something that seems rather insignificant. Look at it. Pray about it.
5. **Look toward tomorrow.** Pay attention to the feelings that surface as you survey what's coming up. Allow these feelings to turn into prayer. Seek God's guidance.

The *Examen* is designed to be a daily exercise, but it can also be tweaked to serve as a guide for reflecting on last year. Where was God present? What sort of joys did you experience? What emotions characterized your 2020? Was God moving you in a new way?

There is no doubt that 2020 was a challenging year. But perhaps it can also be a year that seasoned you for the unique things God has in store for you in the coming year. Give that some thought...and then open your eyes to see what Jesus Christ might be asking you to do as 2021 unfolds.

## Christian Women's Fellowship – Ghostly Tea Report

Dear Members of First Christian Church,

You may recall that in the Fall of 2019, the Christian Women's Fellowship held a Ghostly Tea fundraiser. This event, which required little effort on the part of the C.W.F., netted a nice profit of \$2,164.47. But, then the COVID - 19 Pandemic happened and everything was put on hold and the money from this fundraiser was never spent.

During the Fall of 2020, a Ghostly Tea Committee, composed of Debi Ballard, Alice Gordon, Jane Ridenour, and Cathy Biggs, began to meet and they decided to spend the Ghostly Tea money as follows:

- ◆ \$300 to First Christian's Youth to purchase gym equipment and other miscellaneous items as needed per Claire Baer, Director of Children's Ministries, and Rev. Josh deSteiguer, Minister of Youth Ministries;
- ◆ \$300 to Fain Elementary School, First Christian's P.I.E. Partner (Partner in Education);
- ◆ \$300 to First Christian's Membership Department, as needed for the Bereavement Committee;
- ◆ \$200 to Interfaith Ministries, as needed for the Diaper Ministry;
- ◆ \$200 to Park Place Christian Church, as needed for the Special Needs Playground being constructed for the community;
- ◆ \$700 to First Christian's Property Department, as needed for the repair and painting of the front of the stage in Fellowship Hall; and
- ◆ \$164.47 to Wichita Restaurant Supply for the purchase of a new Rubbermaid rolling cart to be used exclusively in the Parlor and Small Kitchen.

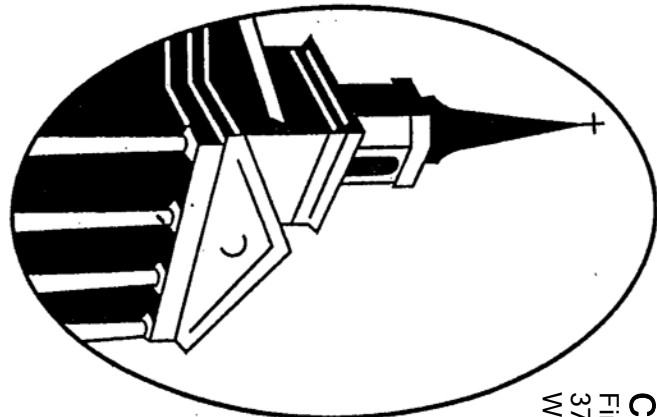
