Ainslee Buckley



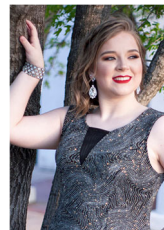

Delaney Murdock



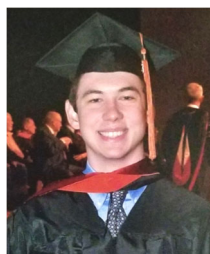
